

You will see that all of the work was done by hand. The building took two weeks to complete. They are beginning to apply plaster now.

We also shared about how well Fauzia Neyvu did on her national exams. She is now a new resident of the Chogoria Girls National High School. Unfortunately, high schools in Kenya are not publicly funded. Her school fees are higher and we are seeking additional sponsors for her to cover these costs.

" I am Fauzia. I am glad to inform you that I scored 386 marks out of possible 500 marks in my Kenya Certificate Primary Examination. I have been selected to Chagoria Girls National School in Meru. I want to be a medical doctor. Here in Kenya, National schools are believed to be well-equipped for learners to easily pass with higher grade to make them achieve their dreams and goals. National schools are costly and most cannot afford them. I am asking if I can continue getting sponsors who can sponsor me in this school. I promise to work harder to achieve my dream of becoming a doctor. Please be praying for me to be a role model in the Ultimate Wings family. Thank you very much to Simpsonville Baptist Church family for your sponsorship to help us stay in school."




EKY SONrise Ladies Retreat June 6-8 in Inez, KY

BY THE NUMBERS

For the calendar year 2023...

- Our Sunday School average was 173 which is up from 116.
- Our average Worship attendance was 278 which is up from 218.
- The Barnabas encouragement team, led by Joy Casey, made 249 contacts which is up from 214.
- Support staff made 488 contacts.
- Our Women's Ministry contacted 47 new ladies who were first-time guests.
- Baylee Branstetter reached out to welcome 19 children of first-time guests.
- We had 93 different families • visit for the first time. Fortythree of those families are still attending worship. Twenty of the families were guests of our members from other areas counties and states. Nine of the 43 families have become members. Twenty-one of the families are actively involved in a Sunday School class or attended one of our Discipleship classes.
- Our SBC Enews has 285 subscribers with a 73% open rate!



Accessing our online community

Church Community Builder (CCB) is a tool to help you get better connected with your church family. You will be able to match names to faces of people you don't know, get contact information and connect with groups which you are involved in.

- Request a login from the church office angie@simpsonvillebaptist.com.
- Once you log in to the online community, you will land on your personal home page. The page contains information specific to you including: a welcome message from the church, your profile box with contact info, a list of your groups. You can change your privacy settings, family photos and contact information. You can add birthday and anniversary information.

To view other Profiles

• To view a profile for another person, click the People tab on your profile page. (If you do not see a People tab it means you have a limited access profile and will only be able to see your profile. Limited access profiles are changed to full access profiles once you have attended for six months.) After clicking People, begin to type a name in the search box. You can use a first or last name. As you type the system will automatically narrow your results. Click the name of the person you would like to view and their profile and information will come up. Security features might be enabled depending on the individual.

To view Groups

• You will see groups to which you currently belong on your profile page. You can also go to find Groups using the Group tab and using the search engine. Once your group is opened you will see the list of those included in each group. You can also search for new groups and request information about any group.

There is also a Help button located in the top right hand corner on any page if you need assistance with your personal profile or group info or just managing the Church Community Builder website.


